APPROVED 5/21/2019

- AT 15 DAYS: FRIENDLY REMINDER LETTER SENT and \$ 25 LATE FEE ASSESSED by FIHOA. INTEREST BEGINS ACCRUING EFFECTIVE ON THE DUE DATE OF THE MISSED MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT.
- AT 45 DAYS: IF NO RESPONSE, DEMAND LETTER SENT by FIHOA
- AT 75 DAYS: IF NO RESOLUTION, ACCOUNT REFERRED by FIHOA TO ATTORNEY FOR COLLECTION (At this time, Attorney is responsible for collecting and FIHOA no longer invoices the debt.)
- ATTORNEY SENDS "NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE LIEN" COLLECTION LETTER within 7 to 14 days
- 60 DAYS LATER: "CLAIM OF LIEN" FILED by ATTORNEY and "NOTICE OF INTENT TO FORECLOSE" LETTER SENT by ATTORNEY
- 60 DAYS AFTER FILING LIEN and NO RESOLUTION : FORECLOSURE by ATTORNEY
